Dear John:

I am in receipt of the request from Natural Light Tubular Skylights (dba Natural Light Energy Systems) to have the 10" unit and 13" unit approved per Arizona Department of Commerce Energy Office Guidelines for Solar Devices (for the Arizona Solar Tax Credit). Under the new Guidelines approved by the Arizona Solar Advisory Council on January 8, 1999, you have met the qualifications as they pertain to the Department of Commerce's Guidelines for these devices. These qualifications, as stated in the State of Arizona Solar Guidelines and Procedures, Section 4: Solar Daylighting, are:

4.3 Product certification:

There are two requirements for product certification.


4.3.1 The basic device must be ICBO approved for the intended installation.

4.3.2 The basic device must be approved by the Department of Commerce Energy Office as a solar daylighting device. The manufacturer or the installing company must submit to the Department of Commerce Energy Office (3800 N. Central Ave., Suite 1200, Phoenix, AZ 85012) a detailed description with accompanying graphics (drawings; photos) for each model with substantial design differences.

Having met these qualifications, Natural Light needs only to supply the purchaser of one of these systems, upon completion of installation, with a copy of this letter stating that the device is a qualified device.
