Dear Bryan:

This is to serve as notice that your request has been approved to have Velux America's Energy Star rated skylights approved per Arizona Department of Commerce Energy Office Guidelines for Solar Devices (for the Arizona Solar Tax Credit). Under the new Guidelines approved by the Arizona Solar Advisory Council in June 23, 2008, your products have met the qualifications as they pertain to the Department of Commerce's Guidelines for these devices. These qualifications, as stated in the **State of Arizona Solar Guidelines and Procedures, Section 4: Solar Daylighting,** are:

4.3 Product certification:

There are two requirements for product certification.

- **4.3.1** The basic device must meet ENERGY STAR® Program Requirements for Residential Skylights.
- **4.3.2** The basic device must be approved by the Department of Commerce Energy Office as a solar daylighting device. The manufacturer or the installing company must submit to the Department of Commerce Energy Office (1700 W. Washington Street, Suite 220, Phoenix, Arizona 85007) a detailed description with accompanying graphics (drawings, photos) for each model with substantial design differences. Having met these qualifications, Velux America Inc. needs only to supply the purchaser of one of these systems, upon completion of installation, with a copy of this letter stating that the device is a qualified device.
